#### CALL FOR PAPERS

The Journal of the Nigeria Association of Teachers of Arabic and Islamic Studies (NATAIS) is a reputable academic journal published annually. Well researched articles in the fields of Arabic and Islamic Studies are therefore invited from scholars of the two disciples to be published in the next edition of the Journal. An article submitted must conform to the following guidelines:

- 1. The first page should give the title of the paper, (surname last), affiliation to the institution, Department/Unit, Postal address, e-mail address and phone number.
- 2. Page 2 of the paper should start with the title of the paper without the name of the author(s).
- 3. Articles must be typed and double-spaced on one side of the paper with a maximum of 10,000 words on A4 paper.
- 4. Each paragraph should be indicated by indentation at the beginning of the first sentence.
- 5. Quotations covering three lines or more should be indented at the beginning of the lines and not at the end.
- 6. Notes and references should be marked serially in the body of the paper and arranged at the end.
- 7. Books, articles, websites and interviews should be indicated using the 7<sup>th</sup> edition of MLA format. Examples are:
